This directory is a curated list of Custom House Agents (CHAs), freight forwarders, and cargo handling professionals compiled by **Lime Export Import Institute** for the benefit of our students, exporters, and trade partners across India.

Whether you are shipping your first consignment or managing multiple export orders, having the right CHA contact is one of the most important assets in your trade toolkit. These contacts have been used and verified by real exporters across India's key trade corridors – from the bustling container terminals of Mundra on the west coast, to the strategic gateway of Chennai in the south, and the inland clearance depots of Ahmedabad serving Gujarat's prolific manufacturing belt.

A Custom House Agent acts as the licensed intermediary between you – the exporter or importer – and the Indian Customs authorities. They file your shipping bills, handle ICEGATE submissions, coordinate with port authorities, arrange inspections, manage drawback and refund claims, and ensure your cargo moves without unnecessary delays or penalties. Choosing the right CHA is, in many ways, as important as choosing the right buyer.

Use this directory to identify the right CHA for your port, product, and shipment type. Always verify licences on the CBIC portal before engaging any agent, and always obtain a written rate card before committing to any service agreement.

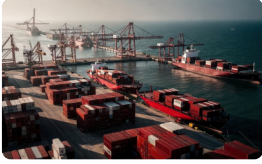

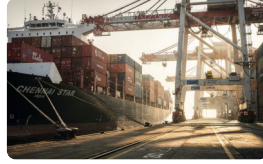
India's export infrastructure is anchored by a network of major seaports, air cargo terminals, and inland container depots (ICDs). The right CHA for your shipment depends heavily on which port your cargo will move through. Below are the three key hubs covered in this directory, each with assigned CHA contacts and operational context to help you choose the right partner.



Mundra — India's Largest Container Port

Adani Mundra Port handles 155+ MMT annually, making it India's single largest commercial port. Ideal for FCL and LCL container shipments, bulk cargo, and project cargo via the west coast. Key gateway for Gujarat, Rajasthan, and north India exporters.

Chennai — South India's Gateway Port

Chennai Port is India's 2nd busiest container port. Ideal for exports to Southeast Asia, Sri Lanka, the Middle East, and East Africa from Tamil Nadu, Andhra Pradesh, and Karnataka manufacturing belts. Handles both FCL and LCL with strong liner connectivity.

Ahmedabad — ICD / Inland Clearance Depot

Ahmedabad's Sabarmati and Khodiyar ICDs handle customs clearance for inland exporters in Gujarat. Goods are cleared at the ICD and then transported to Mundra or Kandla for stuffing and vessel loading. Specialisation noted: **Jewellery / ICS** (Indian Customs Seal) exports.

How to Work Effectively with Your CHA

Best practices from Lime Export Import Institute

A skilled CHA is one of the most valuable partners in your export journey – but the quality of outcomes depends significantly on how you engage with them. At Lime Export Import Institute, we have observed that exporters who follow structured communication and documentation practices consistently experience faster clearances, fewer errors, and better rates. Here are the six practices that make the biggest difference.

1

Make the First Call Right

When calling a CHA for the first time, be prepared with your product name, HS Code (if known), destination country, approximate shipment weight/volume, and preferred port. A CHA who receives clear information delivers faster, more accurate quotations – and is more likely to prioritise your account.

2

Ask for a Written Rate Card

Never proceed on a verbal agreement. Always request a written quotation that itemises the CHA professional fee, documentation charges, terminal handling charges (THC), and any port-specific levies. Compare at least 2–3 quotes before committing to any CHA. This single habit prevents the majority of invoice disputes.

3

Verify the CHA Licence

Ask for the CHA's Customs Broker Licence (CBL) number and verify it on the CBIC portal at cbic.gov.in. Engaging an unlicensed agent can result in your shipment being detained at port and expose you to penalties under the Customs Act 1962. This verification takes less than two minutes and can save considerable trouble.

1

Share All Documents in Advance

To avoid delays, share all export documents at least 48 hours before the vessel cut-off deadline. The minimum set includes: Commercial Invoice, Packing List, GST Invoice, IEC Certificate, RCMC (if applicable), and any pre-shipment inspection certificates. Late document submission is the single most common cause of cargo missing its vessel.

2

Maintain a Single Point of Contact

Assign one person in your team to coordinate with the CHA for each shipment. When multiple team members communicate separately, it creates conflicting instructions, document errors, and compliance gaps. A single point of accountability results in faster clearances and a cleaner paper trail for audit purposes.

3

Follow Up on Shipping Bill & FIRC

After your shipment departs, always follow up with your CHA to obtain: the final Shipping Bill copy (required for RODTEP/Drawback claims), the Let Export Order (LEO), and coordinate with your bank for the FIRC (Foreign Inward Remittance Certificate) once payment is received from your overseas buyer.

📌 **Pro Tip from Lime Export Import Institute:** Build a long-term relationship with 2–3 reliable CHAs at your key ports. Regularity earns you better rates, priority handling, and zero documentation delays. Your CHA should feel like a business partner – not just a service vendor.

Key Documents Your CHA Will Need from You

Have these ready before your first shipment to avoid delays

One of the most common reasons for shipment delays at Indian ports is incomplete or late document submission by the exporter. Your CHA can only work as fast as you provide the right paperwork. Below are the four categories of documents your CHA will require — organised by type so you can build a comprehensive export documents folder before your first shipment ever leaves your facility.

Export Documents (Mandatory)

Every export shipment requires these core documents without exception:

- Commercial Invoice (in USD or applicable foreign currency)
- Packing List (item-wise with net/gross weight and dimensions)
- Shipping Bill (filed by CHA on ICEGATE portal)
- GST Tax Invoice (showing IGST paid / LUT for zero-rated export)
- Export Order / Purchase Order from buyer
- Proforma Invoice (if pre-shipment inspection is required)

Shipping & Logistics Documents

Documents generated during the shipping process — coordinate with your CHA and freight forwarder:

- Booking Confirmation from Shipping Line / Freight Forwarder
- VGM Certificate (Verified Gross Mass — mandatory for sea exports)
- Container Stuffing Certificate (for FCL shipments)
- Bill of Lading / Airway Bill (issued by carrier after loading)
- Mate's Receipt (port document confirming cargo loaded)
- Certificate of Origin (for preferential tariff under trade agreements)

Regulatory & Compliance Documents


Certificates and registrations your CHA will verify before filing:

- IEC (Import Export Code) — Issued by DGFT
- AD Code Registration Letter (from your bank, registered at port)
- RCMC (Registration Cum Membership Certificate from EPC)
- GST Registration Certificate
- PAN of exporter entity
- MSME / Udyam Registration (if applicable)

Product-Specific Certificates (If Applicable)

Depending on your product category — confirm with your CHA which apply:

- Pre-Shipment Inspection Certificate (PSIC)
- Fumigation Certificate (for wooden packaging / agri goods)
- Phytosanitary Certificate (for agricultural products)
- Health Certificate / FDA Approval (for food & pharma)
- FSSAI Certificate (for processed food)
- BIS / ISI Certificate (for engineered goods)
- Hallmarking Certificate (for gold jewellery)

Organise them by category and keep them current. Your CHA will thank you, your shipments will move without holds, and you will be audit-ready at all times.
